

Basic Infrastructure of the Voltahalle

The Voltahalle consists of an open and heated event space with sanitary facilities (women, men, accessible restroom) as well as an integrated bar. The total area amounts to 540 m², of which 370 m² are usable without the pavilion, bar and entrances. In addition, there is a terrace area of 50 m². The forecourt (Ampèreplatz) belongs to the venue and may also be used.

From May 2026 onwards, the hall will be equipped with modern technical infrastructure: truss systems, sound and lighting equipment, projectors, as well as modular stage elements. Upon request and quotation, additional technical equipment can be rented for special requirements. The technical operator is Live-Tec GmbH. Independent use of the technical infrastructure is possible upon agreement.

Furniture

- 350 chairs (shell chairs, anthracite)
- 30 tables (10 units measuring 160 x 80 x 72.5 cm, and 20 units measuring 185 x 80 x 72 cm, both models in white)
- 7 standing cocktail tables
- 18 music stands (black) and 18 stand lights
- Steinway Model B grand piano (on wheels)

Special Features

Column-free overall space with high ceilings and a large window front facing the Novartis Campus, the tram station (Line 1), and the A3 traffic axis, providing abundant natural daylight. Industrial character; exceptionally versatile usage possibilities; extensive technical infrastructure that can be used flexibly and, upon agreement, also independently or supplemented with external equipment. Bar infrastructure available, including refrigerated drawers, sinks, two induction cooktops, beer tap, and dishwasher.

Dimensions

- Total hall area: 540 m²
- Ceiling height: 12 m
- Event area (without pavilion/bar/entrances): 370 m²
- Terrace: 50 m²
- Forecourt: approx. 330 m²

Capacities

Up to 500 persons. Partial subdivision of the hall is possible. Barrier-free access.

Location & Accessibility

Voltastrasse 27 / Ampèreplatz, at the bridgehead of the Dreirosenbrücke, opposite the Novartis Campus. Direct truck access into the hall is possible (via Mühlhauserstrasse). Excellent public transport connections (Tram Line 1).

Parking

Limited number of parking spaces in the surrounding area and directly at the venue.

Catering

Catering can be offered and provided upon request by the company Bisskid. Independent use of the bar as well as collaboration with external caterers is also possible.

Ownership

The Voltahalle is owned by the IWB (Industrielle Werke Basel).
